Sign-In and Sign-Out

Upon arrival and departure, each member must sign in and out at the front desk. Parents or others on the pick-up list must enter the Club to pick up members (no calling ahead, please). It is important for the safety and independence of our members that parents wait by the front desk until their member has gathered his/her things and is ready to leave. **Please keep your member's pick-up list up-to-date.** If you need to add someone to the list, please do so by contacting the club in writing.



Daily Schedule

Your member will arrive to the club between **2:30 pm and 3:45 pm**. During this time they will have the

opportunity to eat snack, and then will be in their Homeroom (new this year). Here they will be discussing Club expectations, and building a safe and positive environment while having fun! Academic hour will come after homeroom (generally around **4:00 pm**). During this time your member will have the choice of signing up for Power Hour where they will be able to read and/or work on homework, or they can participate in other academic based programming. After Academic Hour ends your member will go into Club time (generally around **4:45 pm**). This is a time for your member to participate in impactful programming planned by the Program Specialist. The programs are based around Academic Success, Healthy Lifestyles, and Good Character and Citizenship. It is important for your member to join us for Club time at least 3 times a week in order to get the most impactful experience. At **5:30 pm** on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays beginning in October we will be serving meal. You may pick-up your member any time between arrival and **6:30 pm**.

Starting Off On The Same Page

Returning Club family or brand new to the program, here are things that matter to us to keep you informed and your child safe:

- Sawyer School hours are 2:30-6:30pm. The school is located at 60 Willow Street on the westside.
- Hatch Center hours are 2:30-6:30pm. The building is at 55 South 3rd Ave.
- The entrance to the Hatch Center is off the alley. Parking is available. The lobby is a secure area with seating and a restroom.
- BGC strives to build self-confidence so parents/pick up people are not allowed into the program areas. The child(ren) will put on outerwear, collect their backpacks, and come out to the front desk after being paged.
- It is critical that parents/guardians keep their contact information current. BGCDC must be able to find you quickly.
- The list of approved pick-up people can only be updated in writing to the Club; no phone calls to add a name.
- Meal service will begin in October.
- BGCDC runs on the Sturgeon Bay School District calendar.
- Please label your member's clothing, as our Lost and Found will be periodically emptied.
