GENERAL CLUB RULES

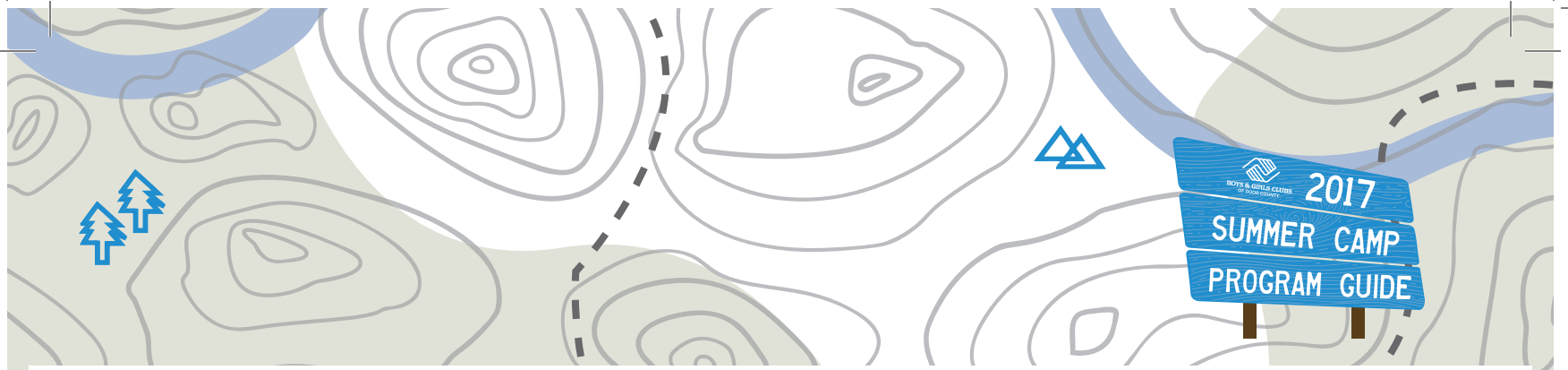
Membership at the BGDC is a privilege. Each member must sign and understand the Club's behavior policy; Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Safe and Be Great.

STURGEON BAY SCHOOL DISTRICT SUMMER SCHOOL

SUMMER CAMP PAYMENTS AND FORMS

- All summer applications must be turned in at Hatch Center.
- We require that 50% be paid at the time of registration or a payment plan be established with the CFO.
- The remaining 50% must be paid by June 12th.
- Existing members must verify their information is correct, as well as fill out a summer application.
- New and returning members will need to complete a membership application in addition to the summer application. This includes the \$10 membership fee.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- Summer scholarship packets are available online and at club locations, and must be filled out and turned in at the Hatch Center with the required documents before it will be processed.
 - Proof of income is required (tax-return, pay-stub, etc).
 - Parents/Guardians must apply annually to qualify.

Application deadline for summer scholarships is Monday, April 10th. All applicants will be notified by Friday, April 28th of scholarship status. No late applications will be accepted.
