



2018 Enhanced Summer Enrichment Program!

Rate Changes

We are pleased to announce our new Summer Enrichment Program which will feature the very best academic, Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics and arts programming normally offered during our fall-spring season. Fees for our 2018 Summer Enrichment Program will be changing and on behalf of the Board of Directors for Boys & Girls Club of Door County, we wanted to inform you. The weekly cost for a member now is based on the income level of a member's household. Please know that our reason for making this change is to help recover direct program expenses; not to make a profit, but also not to lose money. The sliding scale is detailed in the chart below:

Our mission to serve all young people, especially those who need us most, will always be our strongest commitment. To ensure that we can meet that mission long-term, our Club must be on strong financial footing.

This sliding scale streamlines and simplifies the summer fee structure. *A subsidy is built into the sliding scale so many families will not need to go through the individual scholarship application process.* The Board anticipates this is the first year of a two-year process to make adjustments to the summer programming costs, and we look forward to parent feedback.

And, because you asked for it, *we are offering a daily rate* for the first time. Daily registration details can found in our frequently asked question section on the back of this page and will be a flat rate of \$30 for all income levels.

Our caring and supportive staff is honored that you entrust us with your children.

Important Dates

- **February 1** – Scholarship applications available. If your family has had a significant life event that has impacted your financial situation, you may apply for an additional scholarship. Applications will be online at bgcdoorcounty.org and in the front lobby at both sites. They are due back by **February 28 at Hatch**.
- **March 1** – WEEKLY Summer Program Early Bird registration begins. Space is limited so early sign-up is recommended. 50% payment due when registration is submitted.
- **March 16** – Scholarship Award notifications sent to families
- **March 23** – Deadline for family acceptance of scholarship
- **April 13** – Early Bird Registration ends. DAILY program registration begins. Standard fees are in place.
- **May 31** - Parent Orientation Session for Summer Program attendees
- **June 11** – First day of summer programming. Balance of payment due or payment plan established with the chief financial officer.



Frequently Asked Questions

- Is there a daily rate?
 - Yes – based on last year's parent feedback, we are offering a daily rate of \$30 per day for all income levels. We recommend that you call in advance if you want unscheduled, drop-in access as we will only take additional members if we have not reached our daily capacity.

- When can I register my child in advance for the days they would need?
 - *Advanced registration for **days** begins April 13* and is subject to availability.
 - Daily registration is only available if your child will be attending 3 or fewer days per week. (If your child is attending more than 3 days the weekly rate will apply.)
- Why is there no sliding scale for the daily rate?
 - We have a small administrative staff and while we wanted to respond to parent feedback, we want to keep staffing costs low and administration of our summer fees as straight forward as possible.
- Why is there not a discount for summer school or 4th of July?
 - We are trying to keep our cost process as straight forward and simple to figure out as possible for both parents and staff.
- How can you apply for an individual scholarship?
 - Scholarship applications will be available at our front desks on February 1st. Assistance with filling them out will also be available. Income documentation will be required if applying for additional scholarship fund.
- Do you offer payment plans?
 - Yes, if needed, payment plans should be set up when registering. Payment must be made in full by August 1st.
- How are members divided?
 - Five groups: a.) Ages 5-6 (all members must have completed Kindergarten); b.) Ages 7-8; c.) Ages 9; d.) Ages 10, and 11; and e.) Age 12 and above in Teen Center. (Subject to change based on enrollment)
- What are the hours?
 - 6:30 am – 5:30 pm
- Are you licensed?
 - Our rising kindergartners program is licensed as a summer day camp.
- Does every child get academic programming every day?
 - Yes, we are dedicated to being a summer enrichment program.
- When is payment due?
 - 50% payment is due with registration, 50% due at the start of the summer programming on June 11. If families have a payment plan established, payment in full is due Aug. 1st.
- When will my child receive the summer T-shirt?
 - T-shirts may be picked up at our Summer Open House prior to program start or during the first week of program.
- When can I sign my child up?
 - Enrollment starts March 1st. We encourage you to sign up immediately because we do have a maximum amount of members per group.
- Why does the teen program cost so little?
 - We provide a less structured program with fewer field trips.
